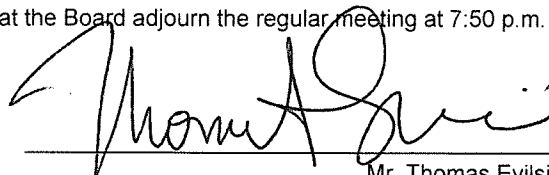
Motion by Mr. Scott, support by Ms. Murray that the Board approve the bills for payment for the period ending May 4, 2018. Motion carried unanimously.
